Costs Associated with Plantings

Landowner is responsible for 100% of the seed costs for any planting option. Cost of seed must be paid in advance of planting. Seed will be purchased by Black Hawk County Conservation Staff.

Field preparation for any planting option is responsibility of the landowner.

Seed Mix: Cost Dependent on seed mix desired or specified in CRP plans and quantity.

Tractor, Planter & Operator: \$150.00 up to 3 acres Additional Acres: \$50.00/acre

Food Plot plantings: 3 acre Maximum Other planting options: 10 acre Maximum

Planting Services Scheduling:

- On a first-come-first-served basis
- Dependent on staff workload and availability
- Dependent on weather conditions

Filter Strips, Buffer Strips, Terraces & Water Ways

The benefits of filter strips, buffer strips, terraces and water way plantings are plentiful.

All of these plantings serve to;

- Control soil erosion by wind & water
- Improve soil quality
- Improve water quality by trapping sediment, chemicals and other contaminants from runoff
- Improve fish and wildlife habitat
- Helps reduce flooding

Prairie Plantings

Prairie habitats host many plants that are rarely found in other habitats. Prairies boast many environmental benefits such as;

- Reduction of soil erosion with deep, drought resistant root systems that hold the soil
- Water conservation as these deep root systems absorb water effectively filtering and slowing water during heavy rain events
- Habitat for many nesting birds as well as amphibians, reptiles, several mammals and insects

Pollinator Plantings

Pollinator plantings are vital to the production of seeds and are necessary for many plants to reproduce. These plantings help to improve water quality, plant and insect conservation and the overall health of any ecosystem.

Consider including pollinator seed mixes in your prairie plantings to maximize the environmental and habitat benefits.

CRP Plantings

Food Plot Plantings

Food Plots offer many benefits to wildlife as well as humans. Food plots offer;

- Supplemental wildlife nutrition
- Protection from predators
- Attracts wildlife for viewing and/or hunting

Seed choice will determine the method of planting. Larger seed will be broadcast while smaller seed can be drilled. Food Plot plantings limited to 3 acres or less.
