Sleepy Hollow Special Use Area Hunting

For youth and persons with disabilities only

Rules and Regulations

- Hunting for youth or persons with disabilities only. *For disability requirements see lowa Code 483A.4 "Permanent disability" defined. Follow IDNR process for disability forms via lowa Code Section 321L.8
- 2. Hunting by reservation in provided SCC ground blind only.
- 3. Archery Hunting Only: Bow or Crossbow *IDNR permit required for crossbow
- 4. Only one valid IDNR deer license/transportation tag may be filled by each youth or person with disabilities per 4 day reservation period. Permit must be obtained from the Story County Conservation Board (SCCB) office prior to hunting.
- 5. SCCB reserves the right to issue or deny approval of permit, permits are non-transferable.
- 6. Permit Requirements:
 - Maximum of 3 persons (1 participant must be an adult)
 - Youth must be 15 years and under with licensed adult 21 years or older. Persons with disabilities may be any age but if under 15 years of age must have a licensed adult 21 years or older.
 - Name of every person in the hunting party and the hunting license number of each adult must be provided on permit.
 - Youth age 15 and under do not need a hunting license. A valid deer license and transportation tag are required. A Hunter Safety class is not required but is highly recommended.
 - Permit must be displayed on the dash of the vehicle so it is visible from outside the vehicle. Park vehicles in designated areas only.
- 7. Permit is for the entire 4 day reservation period. State shooting hours still apply.
- 8. All State of Iowa game laws apply.
- 9. Trapping is not allowed.
- 10. Honor all boundaries and refuge restrictions.
- 11. Leave remains of field-cleaned game at least 50 yards from parking and road.
- 12. Report harvest game to SCC office within 3 days of harvest. *IDNR harvest report procedure still required.
