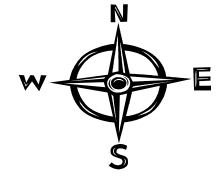


# Swan Lake State Park Campground Map

In case of bad weather, a storm shelter is located in the lower level of the Education Center across the road. The siren will sound during severe weather warnings.

- A book of 7 coupons can be purchased from the Campground Host for Electric or Full-Hookup sites during current camping season. Please do not use coupons if you are camping for 7 or more nights. We offer a weekly rate of \$105 for 7 consecutive nights, no coupons needed.
- **WE DO NOT ACCEPT STATE COUPONS.** Please use our coupons instead for a better rate.
- Check in 5:30 a.m. Check out 6:00 p.m. Registered campers must be 18 years old or older and occupy the site.
- The campground is on a self-registration basis. Envelopes are inside the deposit box at the Kiosk on the east & west ends of the campground if the campground host is not available. Must register the day you come in and have receipt posted at campsite. Campground Hosts are available Memorial Day - Labor Day weekend.
- All non-camping visitors must vacate the park by 10:30 p.m. Violators may be ticketed.
- Only two vehicles per site allowed. All non-camping visitors please park outside the camping area.
- A person may come out to campgrounds and prepay for numbered camp spots. A vehicle (not a tent) must be parked in the numbered site. Registration envelope must be filled out for whoever is occupying the site. Place fees in envelope, seal & deposit where indicated or give to Campground Host. Place receipt on designated post.
- Tents are allowed in non-numbered sites only, however, tents accompanied by a trailer & paying a \$10 tent fee would be allowed on same numbered site. A trailer is defined as a unit that has the capability to use water, sewer & electric hookups. One small tent for kids under 18 is allowed with a trailer in a numbered site at no charge.
- Either tents or trailers are allowed on lettered sites (A-V). A small tent for kids under 18 of the same family is also allowed with a larger tent at no additional charge.
- No camping unit of any kind shall occupy any campsite more than 14 days (the camping unit must leave the campground for one night) unless they occupy sites 1-6 or 22-28 & 35 which are available for long-term camping.
- The cutting of trees – dead or alive – is absolutely prohibited under any circumstance.
- **Pets must be kept on a leash of no more than 6 ft. at ALL times.** Park users must **IMMEDIATELY** clean up after their pets. Violators will be issued a \$75 ticket for noncompliance.
- All fires must be made in designated fire rings or grills. Do not leave fire unattended. **Please do not put trash in the fire rings or grills.**
- Licensed motor vehicles must be operated by licensed drivers only. Mini bikes and various all-terrain vehicles are prohibited at all times.
- Respect other park users by keeping noise at a reasonable level. Quiet hours are from 10:30 pm – 5:00 am.
- One picnic table and fire grill per camping unit. Please do not take these items from other sites.
- Firearms and weapons are prohibited in the campgrounds.
- It is unlawful to consume keg beer within the campgrounds.
- Keep campsite clean and in an orderly manner at all times. Campers shall restore their campsite to the same condition or better than they found it.
- Violation of any state law, county park or recreation area rule or regulation by any member of a camping party is cause for the revocation of the camping permit and the entire camping party shall be required to leave.
- The West Shelter in the Campground is available at no charge to campers on a first-come first-served basis unless reserved ahead of time. Please contact the Office at 712-792-4614 during regular office hours to reserve the shelter. Non-camper visitors must park outside and walk in to allow parking for campers.
