Big Woods Lake Campground

1501 E. Lake Street, Cedar Falls, IA 50613

This campground is a partnership between the City of Cedar Falls and Black Hawk County Conservation. Big Woods Lake Campground sits on the bank of a 65 acre lake that offers no wake boating and fishing. Wrapping around the lake is the Cedar Valley Trail System that offers trail connections to historical downtown Cedar Falls and makes it easy to explore the Cedar River. Bring your bikes, boats, and fishing poles and plan your next getaway at Big Woods Lake Campground!

Black Hawk Park

Located only minutes from historical downtown Cedar Falls, Black Hawk Park is situated on the banks of the Cedar River and offers visitors a variety of recreational opportunities in a natural setting close to the metropolitan area. Black Hawk Park features two campgrounds, a group camp area, gun ranges, a trap shooting range, an archery range, boat ramp to the Cedar River, and multiple shelters as well as several picnic areas to relax and enjoy the scenic views of the river. In addition, the park is connected to the Cedar Valley Trail System, which includes well over 100 miles of hard-surfaced trails connecting Cedar Falls/Waterloo and the Cedar Valley Nature Trail to Cedar Rapids.



Hartman Reserve Nature Center is a 340 acre wooded oasis located in the heart of Metropolitan Black Hawk County. This area extends from an upland bluff, overlooking the Cedar River, down to the banks of the river. Within the forest area, there is a series of ponds, vernal depressions, remnant prairie, open meadows, and the largest tract of upland forest in the County. This high quality woodland is home to a wide variety of plants and animals. Visit the Interpretive Center to learn about the various ecosystems, plants and animals that can be found within the \$40 acres. Be sure to visit the live animal exhibits.

Hartman Reserve has been designated as an Iowa Watchable Wildlife Site and an Important Bird Area. In addition, the Hartman Bluff State Preserve is certified by the Iowa DNR Preserves Board to recognize the significance of the 46 acre tract of upland and lowland forest.

Events

Maple Syrup Festival - This festival is held the first full weekend in March each year. Join us for an all-you-can-eat pancake breakfasť. See the tapped Maple trees, collect sap, and watch a demonstration on how the sap is boiled into syrup.

<u>Halloween Hikes</u> - Designed to delight families, youth groups, scouts and kids of all ages. This guided, light-hearted adventure is complete with illuminated trails and nature related stories. Guests may also enjoy tasty treats.

Under the Harvest Moon - An annual fundraiser to support Black Hawk County Conservation efforts. Guests enjoy a catered meal, live and silent auctions.





Located southeast of downtown La Porte City, McFarlane Park is a beautiful 150 acre timbered park named after a local conservationist, Arch McFarlane. The park serves as a trailhead for the 52 mile Cedar Valley Nature Trail which represents the first rail to trail conversion in the state of Iowa, Nestled on the banks of the Cedar River, McFarlane Park offers river access for boating, fishing, kayaking, and canoeing.

Part of the National American Discovery Trail, the Cedar Valley Nature Trail bisects many miles of natural habitat representing Iowa's historical and current landscapes. The diversity of habitat provides a corridor for wildlife, especially bird species. The trail also connects numerous Black Hawk County Conservation wildlife areas. Park Rules & Regulations

A full listing of all Black Hawk County Conservation Rules & Regulations can be found at www.BlackHawkCountyParks.com. The following is just a portion of the rules & regulations that apply to all Black Hawk County parks;

- Parks are open daily from 6:00am—10:30pm
- Campground quiet hours are from 9:30pm—7:00am
- All pets must be on a leash, 6' or shorter in all areas
- All fires must be in provided rings or grills only
- No driving off of designated roadways
- Hard Liquor is <u>NOT</u> allowed in any Black Hawk County area
