
# Green Valley State Park

Cabins, picnic shelters and 50 percent of the campsites can be reserved on-line by going to iowastateparks.reserveamerica.com or by calling tollfree 1-877-427-2757. Cabins can be reserved up to one year in advance and campsites can be reserved up to 3 months in advanced.


The single room cabins have electricity, heat/air conditioning, a covered porch, a futon, bunk beds, microwave, small refrigerator and table and chairs. Visitors must provide their own bedding, towels, cooking utensils and other camping items. Cabin renters may use the shower and restroom facilities in the adjacent campground. The cabins are available from April 15th to October 15th



A swimming beach, all types of boating, water skiing and speed boating are allowed in a designated area. Sorry, no jet boats or jet skis are allowed. Four boat ramps on Green Valley provide convenient lake access.

A nearly 7-mile grass surfaced trail encircling the lake provide hikers, crosscounty skiers and mountain bikes excellent opportunities to investigate the 1,060-acre park and enjoy its variety of wildlife and native plants. On the west side of the dam a 3.5 mile hard-surface extension connecting the current trail from Creston to the campground is scheduled to be completed in 2015. When completed this 8.5 mile trail will guide you to beautiful McKinley Park in the heart of Creston to Green Valley State Park Campground.


## 12 Mile Lake



Located four miles east of Creston, just off U.S. Highway 34, Twelve Mile Lake is 660 acres and is surrounded by 1,000 acres of upland game habitat. Prairie woodlands above the lake are open to in-season hunting of whitetail deer, wild turkey, pheasant and other upland spe-

Channel catfish, walleye, crappie, bluegill and bass offer angling opportunities year around. Shoreline

access is available th ramps. Boaters may operate at no-wake speeds only. Shallow shoreline areas offer excellent duck and goose hunting.




# Summit Lake


