

Rates and Fees 2012

Campgrounds: All sites are first come first served basis. Each campground has modern restroom facility, with coin operated showers, dump station and water refill available, fire rings with grill grates or grills are located at each campsite.

Oak Grove Campgrounds: Turkey Ridge and Deer Run

Electrical Sites: \$16

Non-electrical sites: \$13 (tents only)

Alton Campground:

Electrical sites: \$13

Shelters

Oak Grove Park: by reservation only, call 712-552-1047

Oak Grove Lodge: \$75

100 person capacity, tables and chairs, fireplace, AC/Heat, refrigerator, grill located on patio, and restrooms

Big Sioux Shelter: \$25

50 person capacity, picnic tables, electricity, coin operated heating units, fireplace, grilling facilities, nearby pit toilets

Open Shelters:

Available first come first served, located by river and through out park.

Alton Shelter: by reservation only, call Alton Casey General Store for reservations: 712-756-4412

Alton Roadside Shelter: \$40

Open shelters: Available first come first served basis.

Cabins

Oak Grove Park: Must call to make reservation, call 712-552-1047.

2 night minimum during summer months, 3 night holidays. All rentals are to be paid for and form signed and returned 10 days after reservation is made. All cabins contain: fire ring with grill grate, picnic tables, toaster, coffee pot, microwave, small dorm fridge (no freezer), bathrooms with shower, ac/heat, hot and cold running water.

Renters must supply own: linens for beds, cooking and eating utensils, toiletry items, food items, etc.

Whitetail and Eagles Nest- \$55 a night

2 sets of bunk beds, full on bottom twin on top, table and stools, sleeps 6-8

Bluegill Bungalow and Fox Den- \$65 a night

1 queen bed, separate bedroom, couch and chair both pull out to a full and twin, bar style counter and stools, sleeps 5

Watercraft rentals

Canoes and Kayaks

4 canoes and 4 Kayaks available for use along the Big Sioux River in Lyon, Sioux and Plymouth counties, or use at the Big Sioux Recreation Area (south of Hawarden). Must call to make reservation and provide proper ID upon request. Must be able to transport on own, 3-4 canoe rentals trailer provided.

\$18 per unit per day \$10 per unit per half day

Paddleboat

May be rented for the day or half day, for use at the Big Sioux Recreation Area only.

\$18 for day use \$10 for half day use

Big Sioux Recreation Area

Vehicle passes are required for admission to this area. Passes are good for the current calendar year (January 1- December 31)

\$20 annual pass- may purchase additional annual passes for \$10, must be purchased at the same time of original pass

\$5 day per vehicle
