KUEHN CONSERVATION AREA RULES

- Camping and campfires are permitted in designated areas only.
- Do not leave fires unattended. Ensure fires are completely extinguished before departure.
- Firewood must be sourced from Dallas County. Kindling and fallen small limbs may be used. Removing branches from trees is not permitted.
- Vehicles must remain in designated parking lots.
- Check-in is 4:00pm. Check-out is 3:00pm.
- Self-registration for camping is at the yellow tube near the Education Center.
- Damaging or removing man-made property, natural formations, or vegetative growth such as flowers, is prohibited.
- Picking edible annuals such as nuts, berries, and mushrooms is permitted.
- Trash must be removed by campers upon departure.
- Quiet hours are 10:00pm 6:00am.
- Trails are designed solely for foot traffic. Hoofed animals, motorized vehicles, and other power-driven mobility devices are not permitted.
- Pets must remain on a leash no longer than 6 feet long. Please dispose of pet waste.
- Respect boundary marker signs.


