Rules & Regulations

RESERVATIONS

You must be 21 years of age to rent a facility.

Reservations can be made by calling our office at (712) 792-4614 or emailing office@carrollcountyiowa.org. Reservations for the Education Center (Wapiti and Bison rooms), shelters and cabins will be available to rent on a rolling calendar basis and on a first-come, first-served basis.

PAYMENT – we accept check or cash

Both the rental fee and refundable damage deposit (on separate checks) are due within 10 days of making the reservation. If fees are not received during that time your reservation will become void. Please call the office for any questions.

Checks should be made payable to the <u>Carroll County Conservation Board</u> and mailed to 22676 Swan Lake Drive, Carroll, IA 51401. A receipt and our rental agreement will be emailed or mailed to you.

REFUNDABLE DAMAGE DEPOSIT

<u>Facility Rentals</u>- Your refundable damage deposit (on a separate check) will be shredded if the facility is left in good, clean condition and equipment and furnishings are returned to their original location and are not lost or damaged. The deposit can be returned in the mail if arrangements are made in advance. Please refer to your rental agreement for proper clean-up procedures.

Camping- We do not do any refunds for camping at any of our county parks.

CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY

All reservation are non-refundable. If you need to cancel your reservation you will receive **credit** to use towards another available date within a one year time frame. All cancellations must be called into our office (712) 792-4614 during our office hours.

CHECK IN & OUT TIMES

The Education Center can be rented between 8 a.m.-10 p.m. The shelters can be rented early in the morning until 10 p.m., unless there is an overnight group renting the shelter the night before, at which time the shelters are available after 9 a.m. Overnight youth groups renting the shelter must be out **by** 9 a.m. on the following day or pay for an additional day. This must be arranged at the time the reservation is made.

PARK HOURS lowa Code 461A.46

All County Parks are closed from 10:30 PM - 5:00 AM except for overnight camping and river access areas, where quite time is then in affect. All non-register park visitors must leave before 10:30 PM.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

lowa Code 123.47

No kegs are allowed. All laws of the state of lowa regarding consumption of alcohol will be strictly observed. Violations of state code will result in expulsion from the building, revocation of rental privileges and forfeiture of deposit. Ensure compliance with Sec. 123.47 respecting possession of alcohol by minors and agree to abide by all rules and regulations of the Conservation Board and the State of lowa.

SMOKING

All Shelters are non-smoking facilities.

PETS

All pets must be kept on a leash of no more than 6ft. or kenneled, except during hunting season in hunting areas. Park users must **immediately** clean up after their pets. Violators will be issued a \$75 ticket for non-compliance. Pets are not allowed inside of Carroll County Conservation facilities.

FIREARMS AND WEAPONS

lowa Code 461A.42

All Firearms, weapons, and explosives are prohibited in all county parks except during hunting seasons in designated county hunting areas. Fireworks are prohibited at all times.

TREES & SHRUBS

lowa Code 461A.39 & 461A.41

lowa Code 461A.45 & 461A.43

Trees and shrubbery must not be cut or damaged in any way. Berries, fruits, and mushrooms may be harvested in the park.

WEST SHELTER

The enclosed West Shelter in the Swan Lake Campgrounds may be rented at no cost if you are a registered camper that day. If you have visitors that will be joining you at the shelter, they must park outside the camping area. You must call or email the office to reserve the West Shelter.

Carroll County Conservation will not be held responsible for any injury to persons or damage to property arising out of or incident to the activities which are the subject of the rental and shall be held harmless against all liabilities, costs, and expenses which may arise in consequence of granting the room rental.

SAUK RAIL TRAIL

33 mile long multi-use recreational trail. The trail is used for walking, biking, running or community events like a 5K. Call or email our office to reserve your event or purchase your Sauk Rail Trail Group Permit.

•Annual Permit: \$15.00 •Daily Permit: \$2.00 per day •Group Permits: up to 25 people: \$15.00, 26 people & more: \$25.00

Group permits cover anyone at your event that may not have an annual/lifetime Sauk Rail Trail Permit. This is required for all events using the Sauk Rail Trail.
