













lowans view outdoor recreation as providing the following personal benefits:

(95%) A sense of peace, relaxation or stress relief

(93%) Health and Fitness

(92%) Positive family activities

(92%) Mental or emotional health

(86%) Healthy childhood development

(85%)The healing power of the outdoors

(75%) Adventure or challenging activities



On average, participants prefer to travel 10 miles or less to participate in outdoor recreation, especially those participants that consider themselves casual users.



Recommendations

- **Embrace diversity, equity and inclusion** to improve access at all levels of need to enhance connection to the outdoors.
- Increase availability and access to outdoor recreation opportunities and amenities for lowans and future lowans.
- Invest in growing our communication systems to be credible, accurate and practical and make it convenient for lowans and future lowans to find and plan for outdoor recreation experiences.
- Increase Iowan's level of physical activity through outdoor recreation activities to improve Iowa's goals for public health and wellness and provide the education and resources necessary for their participation.
 - Hamilton County ranks #55 out of 99 in the County Health Rankings for Iowa
- **Develop partnerships** with businesses, industry and recreation-affiliated user groups to stay relevant in the changing dynamics of outdoor recreation.
