SHELTER RULES:

- Leave the site used in the same condition as found.
- Clean up what debris and litter may be deposited during my stay.
- Due to the large increase in landfill costs, we now have a Carry In Carry Out trash
 policy. Renters are required to take their trash with them. Failure to do so will result in
 forfeiture of the deposit.
- Responsible for any damages done to property within the park by renter or guests.
- Compliance with Section 123.47 of the Iowa Code (1979) respecting the possession of beer by minors.
- Abide by all rules & regulations under the Hamilton County Conservation Board area and all laws by the State of Iowa.
- Pay a damage/cleanup deposit in the amount of \$35 for open shelters, with the Hamilton County Conservation Department. This deposit may be applied by the Hamilton County Conservation Department to wholly or partially satisfy any clean-up costs and/or damage to its property caused by persons utilizing the above listed shelter.
- Park Hours are 5:00 am to 10:30 pm, so all must be out of the park by 10:30 pm unless you are camping in the campground.
