FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

MAY I REGISTER MY CHILD FOR MORE THEN ONE CAMP?

Yes, as long as there are multiple camps for your child's age group. KinderNature camps will repeat themes so if you sign up for the Tuesday in June, the Tuesday in August will offer the same theme. However you are welcome to sign up for both.

Pottawattamie County Conservation Nature Camps try to accommodate all children. Please understand these are active camps and we will be spending a large portion of time outside on uneven terrain, so some activities will adapt better

HOW MANY CHILDREN WILL BE IN CAMP?

Every camp requires at least ten campers and can accommodate up to twenty-five.

ARE STAFF TRAINED?

Our camp instructors come from a variety of backgrounds including professional, year-round educators for Pottawattamie County Conservation, traditional school teachers, and college interns studying environmental studies or education. At least one teacher in each group is 21 or older. All instructors are background-checked and each group has at least one instructor trained in CPR and first aid; all are excited to share outdoor experiences with your camper!

WHAT IS YOUR REFUND POLICY?

Camp registration fees are due within two weeks of the confirmed reservation. If a camper must cancel a reservation prior to the beginning of camp, they are required to notify the Pottawattamie County Conservation Education Staff immediately. A refund of the registration fee will be based upon the following schedule:

14 days (or more) notice 50% refund 13-8 days notice......25% refund 7 days or less notice......No refund

WILL CAMP EVER BE CANCELLED?

If any camp has less then **ten** registered campers it may be cancelled a week prior to camp start date and a 100% refund will be issued. Camp is not cancelled for weather.

WHAT IF MY CHILD HAS A SPECIAL NEED?


