

Slip Bluff Park

Located 3 ½ miles NW of Davis City or 4 miles NE of Lamoni, just behind the I-35 rest area. Slip Bluff is a beautifully unique 450-acre area of savanna, timber, and prairie.

Facilities and Attractions

Campground – Slip Bluff Park features a 16-site, fully shaded campground with gravel camping pads and a modern shower building. With fire rings on every campsite and potable water nearby, Slip Bluff is always a quiet place to enjoy nature and to have a relaxing stay. This campground is first-come, first-served. We do not take reservations for campsites. For current camping rates, please call the DCCB office at (641)-446-7307.

Slip Bluff Lake – This 16-acre lake is stocked with bass, bluegill, catfish, crappie, and walleye. The boat ramp and fishing jetty located on the south end of the lake make this area great for fishermen of all skill sets.

Hiking Trails – There are nearly three miles of hiking trails throughout the savannas of Slip Bluff. Whether you are bird watching, staying active, or just exploring the sights and sounds of nature, Slip Bluff is the ideal place for a quiet hike.

Playground – Located within the campground.

Public Hunting Area – Hunting is allowed on the east end of Slip Bluff. This area is a mix of timber, savanna, and prairie, making it great for deer, turkey, upland, and small game hunting.



Overlook Shelter – Located just north of the campground, this large shelter is one of the most popular spots in the park, as it overlooks the Grand River and you can see for miles! With a restroom and firepit nearby, this shelter is the perfect place for a large gathering or a family picnic. This shelter can be reserved for \$15/day.

East Shelter – Located to the east of the campground, this shelter is surrounded by timber for a more private gathering location and features a newly built pit toilet nearby. This shelter can be reserved for \$15/day.
