THE HISTORY OF THE CONSERVATION EDUCATION CENTER began in the early 1990's. Steve Garst, Joe Halbur, and Dave Olson and others were involved in some of the early brainstorming about the possibility of a regional environmental education facility located in Swan Lake State Park. The 1999 five-year plan for Carroll County Conservation included the first concrete proposal, and a fundraising drive was initiated shortly thereafter.

Construction began in 2003. Doors opened in late October of 2004 with programs and room rentals beginning January 2005. A grand opening was held in April 2005. The price tag of the Center was \$1.8 million, with the local community putting in several thousand additional hours of volunteer help and hundreds of thousands of dollars of local in-kind donations. The funding sources of the Education Center demonstrate the regional support of the project, with 47% of the funding coming from outside Carroll County and 17% from outside lowa. Only 15% of the project was financed through Carroll County taxpayers. The remainder was from local support.

THE CARROLL COUNTY CONSERVATION FOUNDATION is a nonprofit group of interested citizens that meets regularly throughout the year to provide input regarding fundraising and educational programming at the Center. The financial support of the Foundation plays a critical part in meeting our mission by providing needed funds to improve our programs. THE CONSERVATION EDUCATION CENTER

The Education Center is located at Swan Lake State Park and is a regional facility serving Western lowa, contributing towards the local economy and quality of life while providing educational, recreational, and cultural activities. The center is ADA accessible and includes:

- Educational display area
- Kitchenette
- Gift shop
- Boardroom

- Wildlife viewing deck
- Storm shelter
- Prairie restorations
- Backyard wetland
- Restrooms

PROGRAMS

The Carroll County Conservation—Education Center provides programming for all ages! An audio-visual system assists in the facilitation of environmental education in an enhanced educational setting. The center also features a natural resource library available for check out.

Outdoor education opportunities lie just outside the door, with restored prairie and constructed wetland that lies below an agricultural field. Nature and water studies are possible during every season of the year.

The center is open to school visits, youth groups, special interest groups, bus tours, and the public. Public programs are regularly hosted on a wide range of environmental topics by the Carroll County Naturalist.



CLASSROOMS

The center's two large classrooms can accommodate up to 200 guests. The rooms can be divided for smaller events accommodating up to 100 guests in each classroom. These classrooms are located in the Swan Lake Conservation Education Center and offer a unique location for your gathering, with beautiful views. The rooms are available to rent daily from 8:00 AM until 10:00 PM.

WAPITI CLASSROOM

Perfect for any educational or business meeting, this classroom has an audio-visual system with a projector, drop down 6' X 8' screen, speakers—perfect for any presentation. The podium is able to connect with any computer and also provides a DVD, VHS, and CD player. The Wapiti Room is set up classroom style with 21 (18" X 96") tables, if you are planning a social event 2 tables can be placed together for seating of 8. The Wapiti Room is also connected to the centers kitchenette.

KITCHENETTE

The kitchenette has a refrigerator and sink. This is offered for the Wapiti Classroom only but it does share the cleaning supplies, mop, broom, and vacuum with the Bison Classroom

The Bison Room is perfect for any social event. This room has 15 60" round tables and 3 18" X 96" long tables. If you have a short presentation to show during your event we can provide a TV with a DVD and VHS player.
