CAMPGROUND RULES

- Camping permitted only in designated areas.
- Only one camping unit per site may have one small tent for children under 18 only
- One picnic table per site
- Build fires only in provided grills and fire pits
- Do not burn trash
- Bag all trash and fish waste before disposing in dumpsters
- Kegs are prohibited
- ALL pets must be on a leash not exceeding 6' in length, kenneled or tethered at all times
- No destruction of park or private property
- No harm or injury to plants and animals
- Keep vehicles to designated roadways and parking areas, no parking on grass or along roadways
- Speed Limit 10 mph
- Quiet hours are 11 pm 6 am
- Only registered campers permitted after 10:30 pm
- No refunds on canceled reservations

Lake Icaria features two camparounds open year-round: Lake View and Timber Ridge. With 154 total graveled campsites includina. 50 full service. water/electric, 58 electric, and 25 tent sites there is something for everyone. Each site features a fire pit and picnic table for your use. Playgrounds in each camparound. Modern Bathroom/Shower houses, along with handicap accessibility. At the beginning of each campground, there is an RV Dump Station and Water Hydrants for your use. Check-out for camparounds is before 3 pm. TIMBER RIDGE CAMPGROUND

Timber Ridge Campground is a serene and shaded setting surrounded by mature trees. With 39 Full-Service Sites, 23 Electric/Water Sites, and 4 tent sites, this campground can be reserved online up to a year in advance for dates May through September 30. Sites not reserved are available on a first-come, first-serve basis, and are limited to three day occupation.

LAKE VIEW CAMPGROUND

Lake View Campground is surrounded by the lake on three sides, with most sites having a view of the lake. Campground includes 10 Full Service Sites, 57 Electric Sites, and 20 tent sites. This is a first-come, first-serve campground.
