- ⇒ Fall Seeding: prepare your garden bed this fall and frost seed in November or December. Mark where you sow the seed and watch for the flowers to come up in the spring.
- ⇒ These seed packets are ideal for yards and gardens. If you would like to plant native wildflowers on a large scale, please contact our office for information on how to buy seed in bulk.
- ⇒ **Order Deadline is Monday, October 1st at Noon.** Payment is due at the time you order.
- ⇒ Seed packets will be ready to pick up on or after October 24th at the Hurstville Interpretive Center.
- ⇒ All orders must be picked up no later than November 19th. We will not hold orders past this date.
