

SMITH LAKE NORTH CAMPGROUND RULES

04/01/24

1. The campground is open from mid-April to October 31, weather permitting. Camping is allowed only on the 15 numbered sites.
2. The maximum speed in the campground is 5mph.
3. Registrations must be completed within one hour of selecting a camping site. Camping registration envelopes are available on the north side of the open shelter and at the kiosk by the maintenance shop.
4. Fees are \$20.00 per night or \$500/month (30 days) for camping on the numbered sites. A seasonal rate option of \$2,000 (May-October) is available for all sites through a lottery draw held in March. Any sites left after the March draw are available on a first-come first-served basis. Sites must be paid for, properly tagged and occupied by a camper, erected tent, trailer or a vehicle to be considered valid.
5. The registration envelope stub must be placed on the numbered post next to the campsite. The registration envelope with the proper fee is to be deposited in the metal registration container at the kiosk near the Maintenance Shop.
6. One camper or trailer is allowed per numbered pad. One tent may be set up with camper or trailer at no extra charge. Two vehicles are allowed at each individual site.
7. Check out time is 3:00 P.M.
8. Each numbered site is allowed the use of one 30/50 amp electrical outlet and one 110 electrical outlet. The electrical boxes are numbered to match the sites. Each numbered site is also allowed the use of one water spigot, sewer hookup, picnic table and fire pit.
9. Visitors shall park in parking lot by the shelter or parking areas across the road and leave at 10:30 P.M. Quiet hours are from 10:30 P.M.-7 A.M.
10. Pets must be controlled at all times.
11. Campers must move all vehicles, lawn chairs, etc. off the mowed area and onto the camping pads to allow for mowing. All sliders must also be moved in. Campers are to be parked on the gravel lot. Rugs and mats are not permitted on the grass area.
12. The open campground shelter house may be reserved for a fee of \$25. The hours for the shelter use are 6:00 A.M. to 10:30 P.M. Reservations must be made at least 3 days in advance at <https://www.mycountyparks.com/County/Kossuth.aspx>. If there are no reservations, the shelter is available for free on a first come first served basis.
13. The Kossuth County Conservation Board will not be held responsible for any injury or damages to personal property resulting from the ordinary use of the camping facilities.
