In case of bad weather, a storm shelter is located in the lower level of the Education Center across the road. The siren will sound during severe weather warnings.

By your agreement with these terms and conditions you represent that you are 18 years or older (21 years or older if offering alcoholic beverages) and that you authorized to make the registration on behalf of the camping party at your camp site. You further agree to assume full responsibility for the acts, negligence or omissions of the members of your camping party while utilizing CCCB facilities. Additionally, you agree that you have read and understand the policies and rules of the campground.

Violation of any state law, county park or recreation area rule or regulation by any member of a camping party is cause for the revocation of the camping permit and the entire camping party shall be required to leave.

### CAMPGROUND HOST

Host are on duty Memorial Day – Labor Day, Monday – Thursday 12:00 PM – 8:30 PM, Friday – Sundays 8:30 AM – 8:30 PM

### COUPONS

WE DO NOT ACCEPT STATE COUPONS. Please refer to our coupons instead for a better rate. A book of 7 coupons can be purchased from the campground host or CCCB office for electric or full hook-up sites during the current camping season. Please use our weekly rate if you are planning on staying for 7 or more nights.

### REGISTRATION

Check in time is at 5:30 AM and check out time is at 6:00 PM. The campground is on a self-registration basis. Envelopes are inside the deposit box at the kiosk on the East & West ends of the campground, if the campground host are not available. All campers must register the day you arrived and have receipt posted at the campsite.

No camping unit of any kind shall occupy any campsite more than 14 days, the camping unit must leave the campground for one night, unless they occupy sites **1-6, 22-28**, or site **35** which are available for long-term camping.

Pre-pay: A person may come out to the campgrounds and prepay for a camping spot, but a vehicle (NOT A TENT) must be parked in the numbered site. Follow above registration rules.

### CAMPSITE

Please keep your campsite clean and in an orderly manner at all times. Campers shall restore their campsite to the same condition or better than they found prior to leaving. Only one picnic table and fire ring per camping site, please do not take these items from other camp sites.

**DO NOT PUT GARBAGE IN THE FIRE RINGS – DUMPSTERS ARE LOCATED IN THE CAMPGROUND FOR REFUSE.**

### PARK HOURS

Swan Lake State Park is open to the public 5:30 AM – 10:30 PM. Quiet hours are from 10:30 PM – 5:30 AM, please respect other park users by keeping noise at a reasonable level. Any non-register camping visitors must exit the park **BY** 10:30 PM. Violators may be ticketed.

### VEHICLES

Only two vehicles per camp site allowed. All non-camping visitors please park outside of the camping area. Licensed motor vehicles must be operated by licensed drivers only. Mini bikes and various all-terrain vehicles are prohibited at all times from Swan Lake State Park.

### PETS

All pets must be kept on a leash of no more than 6ft. at ALL times. Park users must IMMEDIATELY clean up after their pets. Violators will be issued a \$75 ticket for noncompliance.

### ALCOHOL

No kegs are allowed in the campground or Swan Lake State Park. All laws of the state of Iowa regarding consumption of alcohol will be strictly observed. Violations of state code will result in expulsion of the campground. Ensure compliance with Sec. 123.47 respecting possession of alcohol by minors and agree to abide by all rules and regulations of the CCCB and State of Iowa.

### TENTS

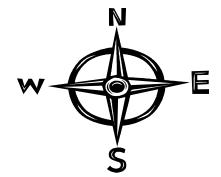
Tents are allowed in non-numbered sites only, however, tents accompanied by a trailer & paying a \$10 tent fee would be allowed on same numbered site. A trailer is defined as a unit that has the capability to use water, sewer, & electric hookups. One small tent for kids under the age of 18 of the same family is also allowed with a larger tent at no additional charge. Either tents or trailers are allowed on lettered sites **A-V**. A small tent for kids under the age of 18 of the same family is also allowed with a larger tent at no additional charge.

Firearms and weapons are prohibited in the campgrounds

### WEST CAMPGROUND SHELTER

This shelter is available at no charge to campers on a first-come, first-served basis unless it has been reserved ahead of time. # Swan Lake State Park Campground Map



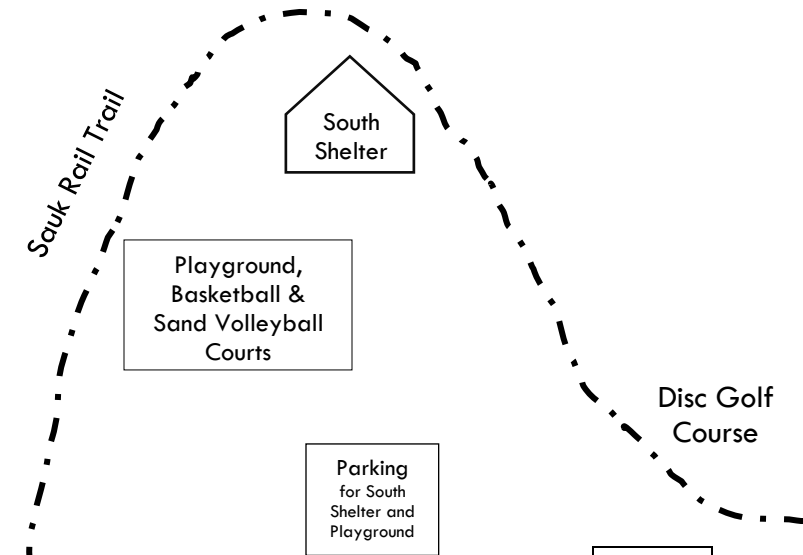
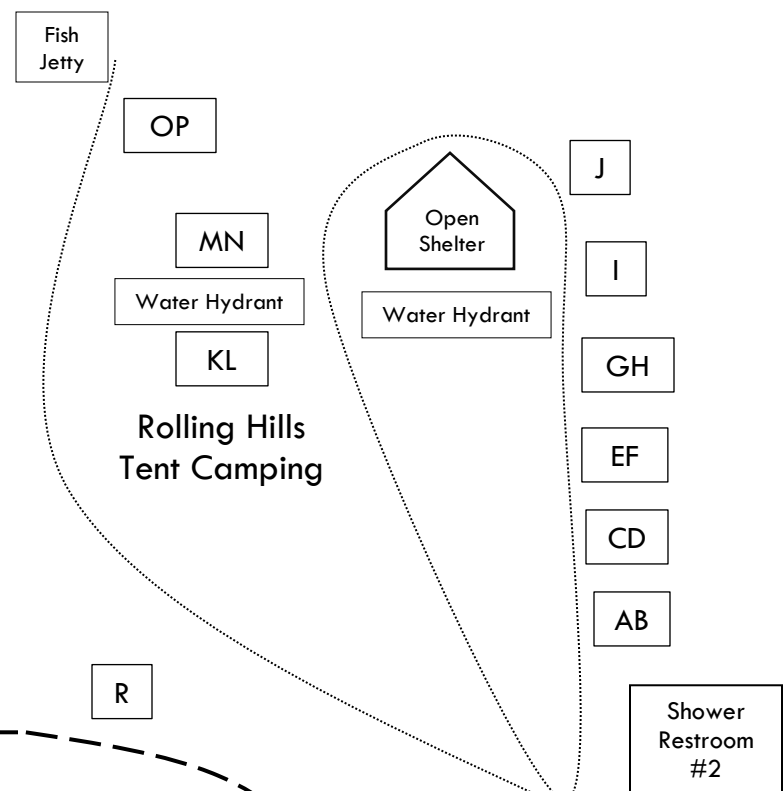

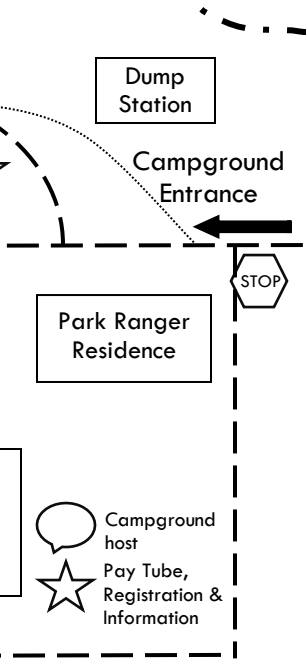
TRAIL TO EDUCATION CENTER
