LOCATION

The rifle range is located just north of the Carroll Landfill – 19111 Kittyhawk Avenue, Carroll, IA 51401
O R across the road from Mid-Prairie Park

PERMITS & PAYMENT – we accept check or cash

User permit is required prior to your use of the range. You may pay a daily fee or an annual fee, payment envelopes can be found at the range and your payment can be put in the drop box. All revenue from purchased permits will go towards improving the rifle range.

Daily Fee: \$2 per day per person

Annual Fee: \$15 per year (permit expires January 10 of following year)

CLEAN-UP

All shooters must pick up their paper targets, frames, spent cartridges/shell casings, and other refuse generated and place them in refuse containers provided.

RULES

- User permit required and fee paid before use of the range is allowed.
- No persons under the age of 18 is allowed to shoot without direct supervision of an adult.
- Always point the muzzle downrange.
- All shooting must be done from stations. Firearms may not be discharged in front of firing line.
- Keep firearm unloaded except when shooting.
- Know where others are at all times.
- Paper targets only. No glass, cans, plastic containers, clay targets, appliances, electronics, or other materials may be used.
- Be sure of your target and what's beyond.
- Wear ear and eye protection.
- No drugs or alcohol or persons under the influence of drugs or alcohol prohibited at the gun range.
- Treat every gun as a loaded gun.
- Please leave the gun range as clean as it was found, if not better.
- No Shotguns
