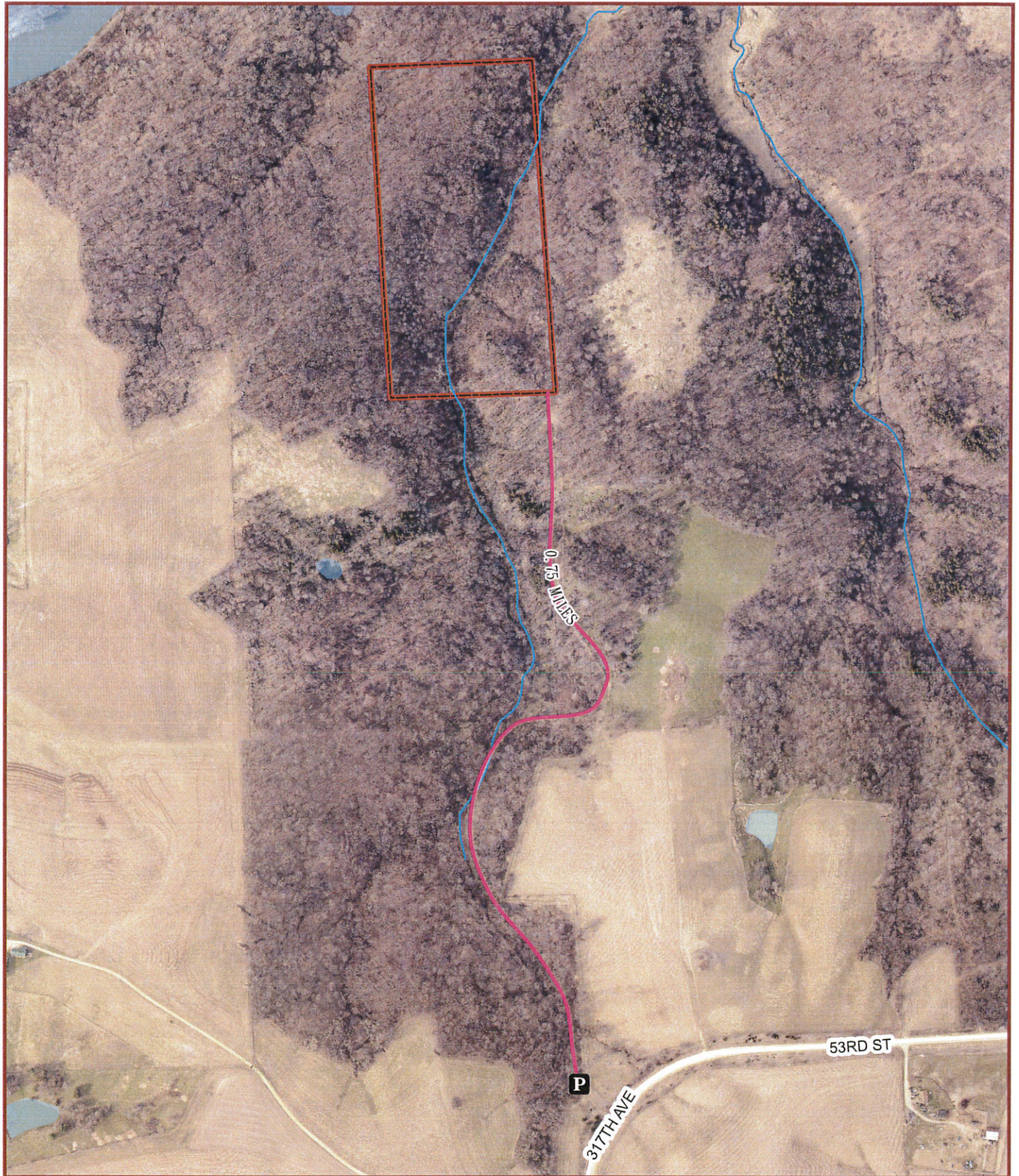


Richardson Timber Preserve

20 ACRES



This 20-acre tract is being preserved as a typical example of Iowa's oak-hickory forest. An abundance of rich and diverse wildlife and flowers can be found throughout. Upland forest provides habitat for many birds including Brown Thrashers, White Breasted Nuthatches, Wild Turkey and Bluejays.

Access to the Richardson Preserve is walk-in only along a clearly marked, mowed trail. Parking lot is located at the intersection of County Roads 317th and 53rd Street, about 8 miles northwest of Preston.
