LAKE ICARIA CABINS

The Adams County Conservation Board has 14 log style cabins. These rustic getaways were designed to provide a camping experience in which you do not need to pull a unit or pitch a tent.

AGE

Responsible party must be at least 21 years of age and present during the entire stay in the cabin. **PFTS**

All of the cabins are considered pet friendly and we do allow pets. There is a \$10.00 per night fee if you choose to bring your pet(s) while renting a cabin. This fee will be collected upon your arrival to the cabin by the park staff. You may choose to pay this fee prior to your arrival by calling the park office at 641-322-4793. All pets must be either on a leash not exceeding 6' or in a portable kennel at ALL times. **CLEAN-UP**

You are required to clean up the facility and grounds and return them to the condition you received them. A cleaning list is posted inside the cabin. Plan to have your facility cleaned and people departed prior to the scheduled NOON checkout time. Paper towels, trash bags, broom, mop, bucket, dish pan, and cleaning agents will be supplied in your cabin to assist you in your cleanup duties.

VISITORS

All visitors (other than registered overnight campers) must depart the park by 10:30 PM.

SMOKING

Adams County is a smoke-free environment. Smoking is prohibited in all buildings.

PARKING

Parking is confined to the designated parking areas. No parking or driving off roadways.

REFUSE

All refuse must be bagged and taken to the dumpsters provided in the area. Please do not use the fire ring as a trash receptacle. Please do not burn trash.

CANCELLATION POLICY

If you need to cancel a reservation, you will forfeit 100% of all reservation fees paid. All cancellations must be made by calling the Adams County Conservation Board Office at 641-322-4793.

REFUND POLICY

All reservations with the Adams County Conservation Board facilities are final. Reservations are non-refundable, unless the following situations occur:

- The National Weather Service has issued severe winter weather conditions and advised against travel.
- We are unable to provide your facility (or like facility) in operable condition for the date of your event.

All requests for refunds must be made by calling the Adams County Conservation Board Office.

KEG BEER

No kegs are allowed in the park.

TENTS AND CAMPERS

Sleeping tents and campers must have their own camp site located in the campground only. No sleeping tents are allowed in the cabin areas. Screen tents for picnic tables, etc. are allowed at no charge.

ADAMS COUNTY CONSERVATION RESERVES THE RIGHT TO ENTER CABINS IN THE CASE OF EMERGENCY, MAINTENANCE AND SECURITY PROBLEMS.

IN CASE OF **EMERGENCY "ONLY"**, AFTER HOURS, WEEKENDS, OR HOLIDAYS, CONTACT THE ADAMS COUNTY SHERRIFF'S OFFICE AT 641-332-4444 OR LOCALY 911. They can page the officer on duty.

All cabins sleep 6 and have two sets of bunk beds (except #9 has one bunk bed and a queen bed) and a foldout couch. Each cabin includes electricity, microwave, refrigerator, table, AC/heat, broom, mop, bucket and cleaning supplies. Outdoors you have picnic tables, water hydrant, fire pit, and charcoal grill. Cabins 1,5,9,10, 11 and 12 have their own restroom, shower and sinks. Modern restroom/shower facilities are nearby for all other cabins.

The cabin renter is responsible for bringing all personal items, towels, blankets, sleeping bags, pillows, cooking utensils, pot, pans, etc.

Cabins 2,3,4,6,7 and 8 have large dorm size refrigerators. Cabins 1,5,9,10,11,12,13 and 14 have an apartment size refrigerator/freezer unit.

Cabins 1 thru 4 are located near the camp entrance and have trails leading to the lake. You will have a great view overlooking the area and lake!!

Cabins 5 thru 8 are located north of the shower house near or on the lake.

Cabins 9 thru 14 are larger cabins located at the west end of the area and near the playground, lake and boat docks.

If renting cabins 6,7,8,12,13,14 you may consider bringing a wagon or wheel barrel to carry supplies more than 50 yards to these lake front cabins.
