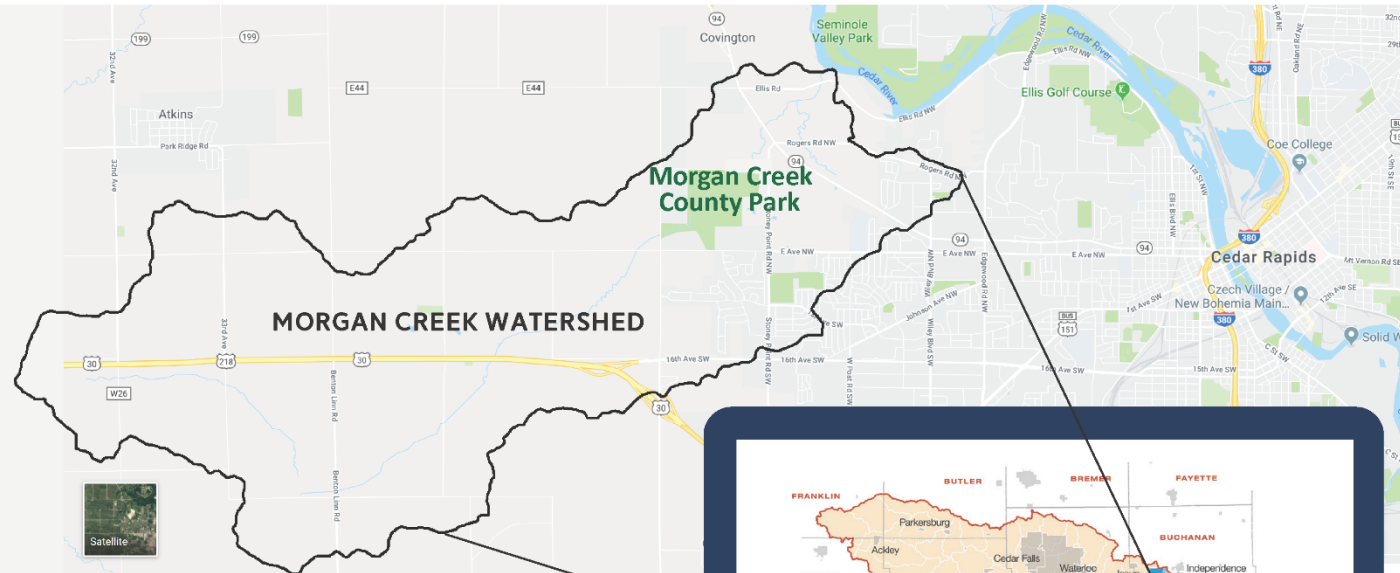

## MORGAN CREEK WATERSHED



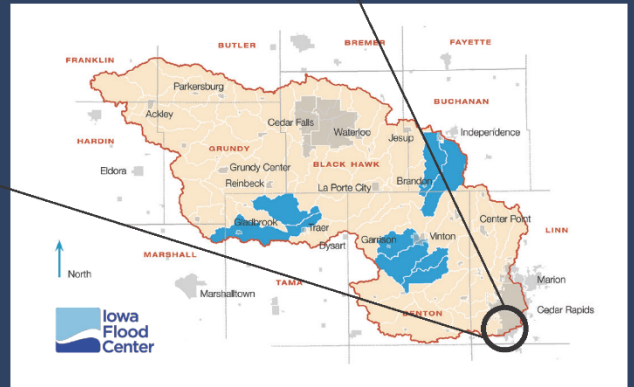

The plan will set goals to improve the stream for people and wildlife, and establish an action plan for restoration. Goals for the master plan may include reducing flood risk, improving water quality, improving habitat for fish, and enhancing recreation opportunities.

### MIDDLE CEDAR RIVER WATERSHED

THE MIDDLE CEDAR RIVER WATERSHED IS A 1.5 MILLION-ACRE WATERSHED THAT SPANS PARTS OF 10 COUNTIES IN EASTERN IOWA. IT INCLUDES SOME OF THE RICHEST FARMLAND IN THE NATION. SEVENTY-THREE PERCENT OF THE LAND IS DEDICATED TO ROW CROP AGRICULTURE. THIS WATERSHED INCLUDES CEDAR RAPIDS, WATERLOO, AND CEDAR FALLS.
