Jackson County Human Resource is accepting Applications for a Park Ranger

Under the general direction of the Executive Director, the Park Ranger manages and maintains all Jackson County Conservation Board management areas. The Park Ranger is responsible for developing and coordination work projects for themselves and seasonal employees, maintaining all park equipment and facilities, and enforcing all park rules and regulations in management areas.

This position requires the operation of all types of equipment including trucks, tractors, mowing equipment, chainsaw, weed eater, power tools, wood splitter, watercraft and all types of hand tools. This position requires travel to all areas managed by the Conservation Board and periodic travel to meetings throughout the State.

Associate's Degree from an accredited 2-year college with major course work related to the natural resource field plus a minimum of 2-years' experience in an outdoor recreation or related field required.

Interested applicants must possess Certified Peace Officer certification through the Iowa Law Enforcement Academy, a valid Iowa Class A Commercial Driver's License, Iowa Pesticide Applicators License, CPR & First Responder certification, or have the ability to obtain each within the 1st year of employment.

This is a full-time position, starting rate of pay is \$22.01 per hour.
