

John F. Kennedy Memorial Park

Seasonal Campsite Rules

1. Access to the campsites will be available April 15 – October 15 annually.
2. Parking available for (2) vehicles and a camping unit. Extra vehicles may be parked in existing parking lot on the south end of the campground.
3. Electrical, sewer, and water will be provided on each site.
4. No decks or sheds allowed. An asphalt pad is provided.
5. The sites must be well kept and accessible for staff to complete regular mowing and trimming.
6. Deposit – If you are successful in the lottery drawing, a non-refundable \$500 deposit is due by November 1 to ensure your site is held. The remaining balance of the fee is due by April 15. If the WCCB does not receive the deposit or remaining balance by the designated date you will forfeit your site for that camping year.
7. The successful applicant that signs the lease agreement will be responsible party for the site.
8. All rules that apply to the Kennedy Park Campground apply to the seasonal sites. Eviction will result for continued violation of park rules by the tenant and guests. All fees will be forfeited.
9. Permanent sites will be drawn every year. If you have a site one year, it does not guarantee you a spot next year.
10. Application process:
 - a. Kennedy Park has (4) seasonal camping sites. One application per household. Seasonal sites are non-transferable.
 - b. Sites will be drawn starting with the western most site and working to the east. *Trading of sites to be closer to friends can be arranged if agreed by all parties.
 - c. Completed application is due at the Kennedy Park Office by October 1.
 - d. Drawing will take place at the October Conservation Board Meeting.
 - e. All fees must be paid in-full prior to April 15
